AND WHEREAS in the year 2005, the Transport Board Law, No. 19 of 1978 was repealed by the Sri Lanka Transport Board Act, No. 27 of 2005, and as a result the administration of the Ceylon German Technical Training Institute was assigned to the Ministry of Transport:

AND WHEREAS it is the policy of the Government to administer all vocational and technical institutes under the purview of one particular Ministry and accordingly, the administration of the Ceylon German Technical Training Institute has been transferred from the Ministry of Transport to the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Skills Development:".
