## Parliament met pursuant to adjournment. The Speaker took the Chair.

1. Announcements by the Speaker: The Speaker made the following announcement:-

"I wish to inform you that a seat in this Parliament has become vacant as the Supreme Court has affirmed the Judgment of the Appeal Court and dismissed the petition for appeal, subsequent to the consideration of the petition for appeal submitted to the Supreme Court challenging the judgment given by the Appeal Court in relation to the Writ application bearing No.362/2015 to the effect that Hon. Mrs. Geetha Samanmalee Kumarasinghe, Member of Parliament for Galle Electoral District, was not qualified to be elected as a member of Parliament or to hold a seat in Parliament and vote in Parliament in terms of Article 66 read with Article 91 (1) (d) (xiii) of the Constitution of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka."

- **2. Presentation of Papers :** The Minister of Lands and Parliamentary Reforms presented the
  - (i) Draft Budget Estimates of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka for the Fiscal Year 2018; and
  - (ii) Fiscal Management Report 2018, issued under Sections 4 and 7 of the Fiscal Management (Responsibility) Act, No. 3 of 2003.

Ordered that the said Reports do lie upon the Table.

**3.** Business of the Parliament: The Leader of the House of Parliament moved,— That the proceedings on Item No. 1 of Public Business appearing on the Order Paper be exempted at this day's sittings from the provisions of the Standing Order No.7 of the Parliament and the motions agreed to by Parliament on 08.03.2016.
