3. Excise (Amendment) Bill : Order for Second Reading read.

The Minister of Lands and Parliamentary Reforms on behalf of the Minister of Finance and Mass Media moved,— That the Bill be now read a second time.

(At 11.30 a.m. the Deputy Chairman of Committees took the Chair.)

Bill accordingly read a second time.

The Minister of Lands and Parliamentary Reforms on behalf of the Minister of Finance and Mass Media moved,— That the Bill be referred to a Committee of the whole Parliament.

Clause 1

Enacting Clause and Title

Question that the Enacting Clause and Title stand part of the Bill, put, and agreed to.

Bill reported with Amendments.

The Minister of Lands and Parliamentary Reforms on behalf of the Minister of Finance and Mass Media moved,— That the Bill, be now read the third time.

Bill, as amended, accordingly read the third time and passed.

4. Regulations under the Finance Act : The Minister of Lands and Parliamentary Reforms on behalf of the Minister of Finance and Mass Media moved,— That the Regulations made by the Minister of Finance and Mass Media under Section 6 (2) read with Section 8 of the Finance Act, No. 11 of 2006, relating to Teledrama, Film and Commercial Levy and published in the Gazette Extraordinary No. 2044/21 of 07th November 2017, which were presented on 23.01.2018, be approved.

Question put, and agreed to.

5. Notification under the Excise Ordinance : The Minister of Lands and Parliamentary Reforms on behalf of the Minister of Finance and Mass Media moved,— That the Notification made by the Minister of Finance and Mass Media, under Sections 2, 12, 22 and 25 read with Section 32 of the Excise Ordinance (Chapter 52) relating to Excise Duty on import of non-potable spirits and published in the Gazette Extraordinary No. 2050/11 of 19th December 2017, which was presented on 19.02.2018, be approved.
